Key Elements of a Huddle

As we begin the 2011-2012 School Year, I always think it's a good idea to revisit the key ingredients of an FCA Huddle:

FUN- Make it Fun ☺...Ice Breakers... Fun Game...Bible Trivia....Schedule a gym night...Pizza get together...be creative!

FOOD- Physical food- Provide food and refreshments (donuts/snacks/pizza) ...and they WILL come! ☺
Spiritual food- Prayer...Worship music (guitar- singing, CD) "Message"; Guest Speaker; Bible Study; Devotional; Prayer Requests; Prayer...Closing

FELLOWSHIP- FCA should provide an avenue for Christian Fellowship on Campus...However, it is important that we encourage students to get plugged into their local Churches to be fed, grow in Their Walk, and seek Christian Fellowship.

FAMILY- Connect as a FCA Family on your perspective Campus...But, also to get involved with the Greater Houston Area FCA Family through events... FCA Game Day Rally, Fields of Faith, etc.

***Time...**Length of FCA Huddle Meeting time is a variable we must adjust to... some huddles have 30 to 40 minutes and some have only 15 minutes...again, be creative!!

***Leadership...**Another area we strive for is for our huddles to be Student Led!

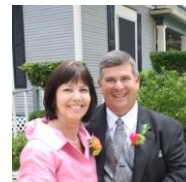
